

Award conditions WUT-Champions

Qualification for WUT-Champions

Qualifications can be obtained at all international shows approved by the FCI and its national associations, awarding the CACIB, or at national shows (catalog shows/specialty shows/club winner shows) where a CAC is awarded.

Awarding of the title

The title is only awarded to Dachshunds owned by persons who belong to a member association/club of the WUT.

WUT-Youth-Champion award conditions

Qualifying certificates can only be earned in the junior class, i.e., between 9 and 18 months of age. Every male/female dog with the "Excellent 1" qualification automatically earns one qualification.

The title is awarded after four entitlements have been awarded in at least two different countries.

One qualification can be obtained by a passed Spurlaut-, Brackier-, Stöbern/Flushing- (including Waldsuche/Forest Search and Sauhatz/Wild Boar Chase), Vielseitigkeits/Versatility-, Schweiss/Blood Tracking- or Earthwork Test (including Kaninchenschleppe-Herausziehen/Rabbit Drag-Draw and Kaninchensprengen/Rabbit Bolting).

Proof of the corresponding examination must be provided up to and including the 18th month of life.

The shows entitlements must have been awarded by at least three different judges.

Abbreviation: **WUT-JCh**

WUT-Show-Champion award conditions before 08.02.2025

The best male/the best female (with a rating of excellent 1) from the adult classes (Open Class, Intermediate Class, Champion Class, Working Class) acquires a qualification for the WUT Champion.

In the case of international shows, these are exclusively the winners of the CACIB. At all other shows, the entitlement to the WUT Champion will be awarded in the same way as the CACIB is awarded.

So only one adult male and one adult female per breed can use the result as a candidate for the WUT Champion.

The title is awarded after four entitlements have been awarded in at least two different countries. In addition, for the homologation of the title, proof must be provided of a passed Spurlaut-, Brackier-, Stöbern/Flushing- (including Waldsuche/Forest Search and Sauhatz/Wild Boar Chase), Vielseitigkeits/Versatility-, Schweiss/Blood Tracking- or Earthwork Test (including Kaninchenschleppe-Herausziehen/Rabbit Drag-Draw and Kaninchensprengen/Rabbit Bolting).

The shows entitlements must have been awarded by at least three different judges.

There must be a minimum interval of 12 months and one day between the first and the last show entitlement. There is no upper limit to the length of time for obtaining entitlements.

WUT-Show-Champion award conditions after 08.02.2025

The best male/the best female (with a rating of excellent 1) from the adult classes (Open Class, Intermediate Class, Champion Class, Working Class) acquires a qualification for the WUT Champion.

In the case of international shows, these are exclusively the winners of the CACIB. At all other shows, the entitlement to the WUT Champion will be awarded in the same way as the CACIB is awarded.

So only one adult male and one adult female per breed can use the result as a candidate for the WUT Champion.

The title is awarded after four entitlements have been awarded in at least two different countries. In addition, for the homologation of the title, proof must be provided of a passed Spurlaut-, Brackier-, Stöbern/Flushing- (including Waldsuche/Forest Search and Sauhatz/Wild Boar Chase), Vielseitigkeits/Versatility-, Schweiss/Blood Tracking- or Earthwork Test (including Kaninchenschleppe-Herausziehen/Rabbit Drag-Draw and Kaninchensprengen/Rabbit Bolting).

WUT-Veteran-Show-Champion award conditions

Qualifying certificates can only be earned in the veteran class, i.e., from the age of 8 years. Every male/female dog with the "Excellent 1" qualification automatically earns one qualification.

The title is awarded after three entitlements have been awarded in at least two different countries.

In addition, for the homologation of the title, proof must be provided of a passed Spurlaut-, Brackier-, Stöbern/Flushing- (including Waldsuche/Forest Search and Sauhatz/Wild Boar Chase), Vielseitigkeits/Versatility-, Schweiss/Blood Tracking- or Earthwork Test (including Kaninchenschleppe-Herausziehen/Rabbit Drag-Draw and Kaninchensprengen/Rabbit Bolting).

The shows entitlements must have been awarded by at least two different judges.

Abbreviation: **WUT-VetCh**

WUT-Working-Champion award conditions before 08.02.2025

The prerequisites for the award are: A passed CACIT test (FCI) or a passed Grand Prix of the Earth Dogs (GPE)

and

a Prize 1 in a Vielseitigkeitsprüfung/Versatility Test (VP) or a Vollgebrauchsprüfung/Utility Test (VGP) or a comparable test (approved by the WUT).

The tests shall be taken in 2 different countries.

Additionally, 2 Formwerte/Evaluation Scores at International Shows with at least a SG/Very Good under 2 different conformation judges, in 2 different countries, in the Zwischenklasse/Intermediate Class or Championklasse/Champion Class or Gebrauchshundklasse/Working Class or in the Offene Klasse/Open Class without time limitations

Abbreviation: **WUT-WorkCh**

WUT-Working-Champion award conditions after 08.02.2025

The prerequisites for the award are: A passed CACIT test (FCI) or a passed Grand Prix of the Earth Dogs (GPE)

and

a Prize 1 in a Vielseitigkeitsprüfung/Versatility Test (VP) or a Vollgebrauchsprüfung/Utility Test (VGP) or a comparable test (approved by the WUT).

The tests shall be taken in 2 different countries.

Additionally, 2 Formwerte/Evaluation Scores at Shows approved by the FCI and its national associations with at least a SG/Very Good under 2 different conformation judges, in 2 different countries, in the Jugendklasse/Youth Class, Zwischenklasse/Intermediate Class or Championklasse/Champion Class or Gebrauchshundklasse/Working Class or in the Offene Klasse/Open Class without time limitations
