
113.1 Inclining Topline - Higher in the Rear (faulty)


















171.1 Pincer Bite (tolerated, faulty)







172.1 Partial Pincer Bite (tolerated, faulty)







173.1 Kulissengebiss [Teeth not in Straight Line, some Teeth even Partially in Front of another Tooth] (faulty)







174.1 Overshot Mouth (Eliminating Fault)








#### **Dentition Evaluation Table**

(According to FCI Standard No. 148, 09 MAY 2001, and the WUT Commentary to the Standard, 2001)

Missing Incisor	disqualified
Missing Canine	disqualified
Base Narrow Canines	disqualified
base Natiow Califies	disqualified
1 or 2 missing PM1	very good
3 or 4 missing PM1	disqualified
One missing PM2, provided no additional teeth are missing	
(M3 are not considered)	very good
Missing PM2 plus additional missing tooth	
(M3 are not considered)	disqualified
One or several missing PM3, PM4, M1 or M2	disqualified
The M3 are never considered	No Fault
Pincer Bite *	very good
Partial Pincer Bite *	very good
Kulissengebiss, Palisadengebiss	disqualified

\* Please note article13.2b, last paragraph. Special attention shall be paid to the pincer bite due to advanced age (only applies to teckels of 4 years and older).

At German Conformation shows and Zuchtschaus the pedigrees of teckels, which have received the evaluation score of "disqualified", shall be collected by the judge and submitted to the Breed Book Office in Duisburg, together with the judge's report.
